- To support my child's behaviour by subscribing to the school's positive behaviour plan.
- To ensure my child attends school on time each day and is absent only when necessary, at which time I will inform the school.

- To attend parents' meetings for discussions about my child's progress.
- To monitor my child's use of the computer at home and support them with online learning.
- To provide my child with the correct uniform and PE kit.
- To supervise my child before 8.50 a.m. and after 3.25/3.30 p.m. on the school site and take care of the school environment.
- To support school in following national, local and school policy and procedures with regard to safeguarding children.
- To use social media only when personally appropriate and to liaise with school and resolve matters face to face.
