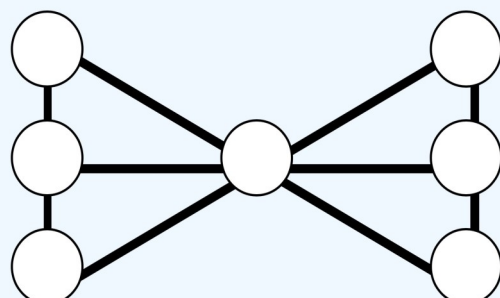


Maths Puzzle Time...
